ENTRY FEE: \$4.00 per exhibit, pair or group plus \$3.00 bedding
per stud or school

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Open to all Bovine breeds
2. Age of the animal to be calculated from 14 February 2012.
3. All animals to have rings or nose clips and should be under control by an experienced groom at all time.
4. Female with calf at foot—calf must be under 8 months.
5. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure all animals entered in classes are ready when Stewards call the class.
6. All exhibitors should enter the Grand Parade after judging, except those considered by the Stewards to be unable to be controlled.
7. Breed must be stated on the entry form, Johne's Disease Declaration and NILS forms returned.
8. Handlers 13-19 years can lead a bull under 20 months.
9. The decision of the Judge as to age and merit shall be final.
10. Prize money will be presented by a Cattle Steward.
11. The Stewart reserves the right to alter classes on the day.
12. Entry fees must accompany entries.

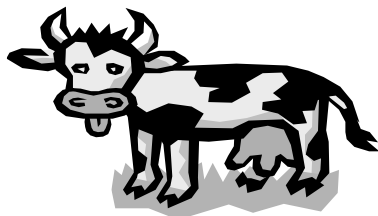

ENTRY FEE: \$4 per exhibit.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1 As listed on page 2 of the booklet
- 2 All Steers & Heifers must be on the showground by 8:00am for weighing if the steward decides weighing is necessary
- 3 They will be judged on , projected carcase quality as if they would killed today.
- 4 Entry to be Milk Tooth Steer & rings or nose pliers must be used.
- 5 Classes will be decided on the day, Most likely Lightweight (Class S1) - up to 360kg. Middleweight (class2) - 360—410kg.and Heavyweight (Class S3) — 401kg & over.
